

## The Lily Group Seed Distribution 2012-2013

Welcome to the forty second annual seed list issued by the Lily Group. This has been a difficult growing season for lily enthusiasts in the UK but a wide range of seeds has still been contributed. However, as in previous years, we are particularly fortunate in having such loyal international donors with contributions received from fourteen different countries. Many of you will have heard of the untimely death earlier in 2012 of the Danish lily enthusiast, John Lykkegaard. A selection of John Lykkegaard's lily seed has been provided by his lily colleague Ole Larsen.

The price of seeds stays at 50p per packet but there are **significant changes to the process of distribution. These are described on pages 27 to 29.** Seed contributors will be rewarded with 1 free pack of seeds for every 2 contributions of species lilies, and 1 free pack for every 3 contributions of everything else. This is subject to individual contributions being large enough to provide three or more packets of seed & free packets are limited to a total of ten.

The importation of seeds into Australia, New Zealand and the United States is strictly controlled & the attention of members living in these countries is drawn to the need to observe their national regulations. The Australian & New Zealand authorities publish lists of plant species, seeds of which may be imported. Members living in the United States must send a copy of a 'Small lots' import permit available free of charge at:

## **Division VI Aurelian & Trumpet hybrids**

Lilies & Aurelian hybrids derived from Asiatic species including *L henryi* but excluding those derived from *LL auratum*, *speciosum*, *japonicum* and *rubellum*

## **Division VII Oriental hybrids**

Hybrids of Far Eastern species such as *L auratum*, *L speciosum*, *L japonicum* and *L rubellum*, including any of their hybrids with *L henryi*.

### Postal ordering

1. When ordering by post, please print your name & address clearly on the order form provided and order by number only, in numerical

sequence. Orders that are difficult to read or do not follow the above procedure will have to be put aside to be dealt with as time permits.

2. If you have an email address, please enter this on the order form. This will make communication easier should any query arise.

### **General points for ordering**

1. Please do not order more than a single packet of any one item in the list.
2. Please do not ask for seeds to be selected for flower colour or other criteria. It is not possible to enter into discussion about the choice of seeds during the distribution.
3. Most seeds packets will only be numbered and not labelled with the name of the seed. It is important, to retain your copy of the list to identify your seeds.
4. Seeds will be sent in padded envelopes. Please do not enclose an envelope with your order.
5. Bulblets and bulbils cannot be sent outside of the European Union.
6. Members resident in the USA are reminded that they must supply a copy of their import permit and address label issued by USDA. Also, USDA restrictions limit imports to a maximum of 50 packets of seed.
7. **Orders will be accepted up to the 15<sup>th</sup> of March 2013, and all orders will be despatched by the end of that month.**

## Payment

Please note seeds will only be sent out once payment has been received.

By far the easiest and quickest method of payment for the Lily Group to process is to use **Paypal**. This is our preferred method for receiving payments for seeds.
