Additional information on liliium seed lots

1. The following species are available in good quantities this year: *L. ciliatum*, *L. martagon*, *L. martagon album*, *L. pyrenaicum*, *L. pyrenaicum rubrum*, *L. szovitisianum*.

2. ***L. japonicum*** is often considered to be a difficult species in cultivation. Mr Ihara offers these comments: "Lilium japonicum grows wild in hills and low mountains in thickets on slopes.

We grow Lilium japonicum in a net greenhouse (ceiling is vinyl) that gets full sun all morning. When the temperature exceeds 30°C, a 30% shade net is used.

As countermeasures against bulb rot: soil drainage, control of soil temperature rise, do not irrigate leaves, irrigate in the evening during hot weather. Liquid fertilizer is given once every two weeks except in summer."

Ordering Seeds

Members may order seed by email or by post using the order form supplied. Seed donors will receive 1 free pack of seeds for every 2 contributions of species lilies and 1 free pack for every 3 contributions of anything else to a maximum of 10 free packets.

This is conditional on individual contributions being sufficient to provide three plus packets of seed; free packets are limited to a total of ten. Only members whose seed is listed will be eligible for free packets.

Donors may order up to 80 packets of seed per household and non-donors up to 30 packets. The cost is 70p per packet.

Charges for packing & postage are:

Members outside Europe: £5.00 for packets under 100g
£7.00 for packets up to 250g

Members in Europe: £4.00 for packets under 100g
£5.00 for packets up to 250g

UK members: £2.50

Tracked postage can be arranged. A 250g letter to Canada or the USA would cost £12.50 and £14.00 to Australia & New Zealand.

When your order has been filled, the order form will be emailed back to you. It will now confirm what seeds you have got and how much the total cost is. You will be sent a PayPal invoice by our Treasurer/Finance Officer, Irene Hopton-Scott.

General points for ordering

1. Please do not order more than a single packet of any one item in the list.
2. Most seeds packets will only be numbered and not labelled with the name of the seed. It is important, to retain your copy of the list to identify your seeds.
3. Seeds will be sent in padded envelopes. Please do not enclose an envelope with your order.

4. Bulblets and bulbils cannot be sent outside of the United Kingdom.
5. Members resident in the USA are reminded that they must supply a copy of their import permit and address label issued by USDA. Also, USDA restrictions limit imports to a maximum of 50 packets of seed.
6. **Orders will be accepted up to the 16th March 2023; we aim to despatch all orders by the end of the month.**

Payment

Please note seeds will only be sent out once payment has been received.

PayPal is our preferred method of payment for seeds. **It is not necessary to have a personal PayPal account in order to make an online payment.**

Payment may also be made by cheque, payable to **The Lily Group**. If paying by cheque, please write "Not to exceed" with the amount between the cheque crossing; alternatively, please provide a lengthy list of substitutes.

Payment by credit card is not available.
